- Formed July 20, 2001
- 98% of eligible staff are members for a current total of 57
- Includes Firefighter/EMTs, Firefighter/Paramedics, Engineers, and Lieutenants
- 30 of the 51 members – 55% – live within the Town of Castle Rock
- 39 of the 51 members – 70% – live within 15 miles of the town
- Has raised over \$130,000 for MDA
- Has raised over \$450,000 for charitable causes in Castle Rock
- Raised over \$66,000 for the FDNY Fallen Firefighters Fund
- Participates in the Adopt-a-Highway program on HWY 85
- Participates in the Adopt-a-Family program during the holiday season
- Member of the Colorado Professional Fire Fighters Association
- Member of the Colorado AFL-CIO
